Red became Bryan's favorite color and although he appeared to be on the quiet side, his friends said he was talkative, funny and kind. He loved life and was never afraid to try new things or make fun of himself to make others laugh.

Bryan had a gift for making people feel comfortable. He was a quiet leader with a great sense of humor and everyone loved to be around him. For Bryan it was about playing a game with his friends and he often said, "*you gotta have fun*". He was a gifted athlete and musician who played bass guitar with his award winning band, *Unprecedented*.



On August 2, 2004, Bryan passed away in his sleep from unknown causes. He was 12 ½ years old and his death has left a void within his family, his teams and the community. Bryan once described himself as "*a bass player who likes sports and loves music*" and he is sorely missed. **Rock On # 8, we love you!!**

Renamed in 2006 as a dedication to Bryan the Memorial Scholarship was created to reward high school seniors for their outstanding involvement in the White Marsh Recreation Council.
